Preface: I was reminded by Jo Ann Wanat, our NewsLink editor, on Sunday (May 26th) that I had not given her my June message yet and she knew that I was going to be at Annual Conference for three days this week. I told her that I had not even given it a thought. She said "go back a few years and use a June message that I had used earlier. Well, here I sit on Memorial Day looking. An 11-year-old boy, Preston Sharp was visiting his veteran Grandfather's grave when he realized that not all of the veteran graves had flags on them. This really tore Preston up inside and he couldn't let go of the feeling that these vets deserved more. His mom encouraged him to do something about it, and he did. Preston started taking up collections to place flags on every veteran's grave at his local cemetery. And come rain or heat Preston is out there thanking our late veterans and placing flowers and flags on their graves. And seeing how this young boy's kindness spread in the most incredible way will warm your heart!"

There are many inspirational stories just like this happening right here in our own Greers Ferry Community, but like the local and national news, we seem to concentrate more on the bad things that happen around us.

I recall how our famous, Charlie Brown is constantly struggling with this. One day Charlie Brown was talking to his friend, Linus, about the pervasive sense of inadequacy he feels all the time, you see, Linus, says Charlie Brown "it goes all the way back to the beginning. 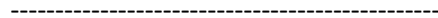
